Pennsylvania Non-Life-Sustaining Businesses to Close

Pennsylvania Gov. Wolf's Closure Edict ordered all Pennsylvania non-life-sustaining businesses to close their physical locations. Enforcement will begin **Monday, March 23**. In the last 72 hours, Stradley Ronon's Government Affairs Group has jumped into action to help clients interpret and seek clarification on the order, apply for waivers for their businesses, and also apply for Federal Emergency Loans. Pennsylvania businesses seeking waivers can access the form here: <u>Business Waiver Application</u>. When completing the form, companies should include that they are maintaining only a skeleton staff necessary for essential services, with no sales, marketing or other unnecessary personnel reporting. Businesses can also email <u>RA-dcedcs@pa.gov</u> for clarification, and <u>RA-dcexcemption@pa.gov</u> for waivers and exemptions help.
